Sharing the room with some of the most dedicated healthcare professionals in the country was both humbling and energising, and a reminder of why we do what we do.

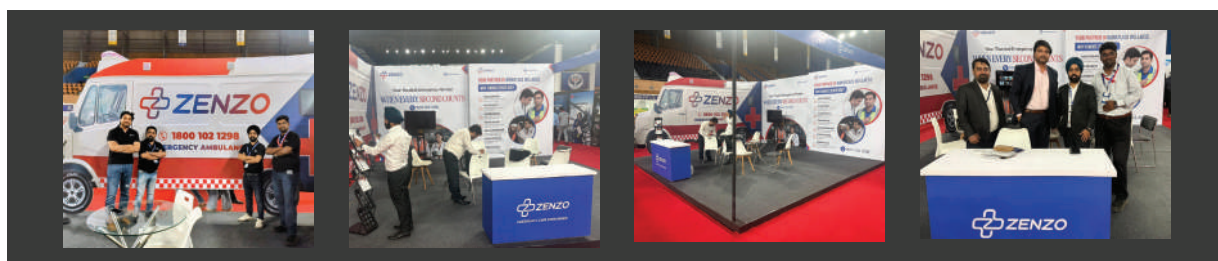


ZENZO SHOWS UP AT THE GOA OSH EXPO & SUMMIT 2026

ZENZO LAUNCHES ALS AMBULANCE AT HOTEL CHALET - NEW DELHI

Zenzo Ambulance is now deployed at Hotel Chalet, New Delhi, marking an important step in our journey to bring emergency care closer to where people live, work, and stay. With a fully equipped ALS Ambulance on-site, guests and staff have access to immediate, high-quality emergency medical response without having to wait for help to arrive.



HEFT ENERGY GETS STRONGER WITH FIVE NEW BLS AMBULANCES

Zenzo has deployed 5 BLS Ambulances across two new locations for HEFT Energy, with 4 units in Bidar and 1 in Koppal. This expansion ensures that as the organisation grows, its emergency response capabilities grow with it. With a stronger fleet now in place, HEFT Energy's workforce across both locations can count on immediate, reliable care whenever it is needed.

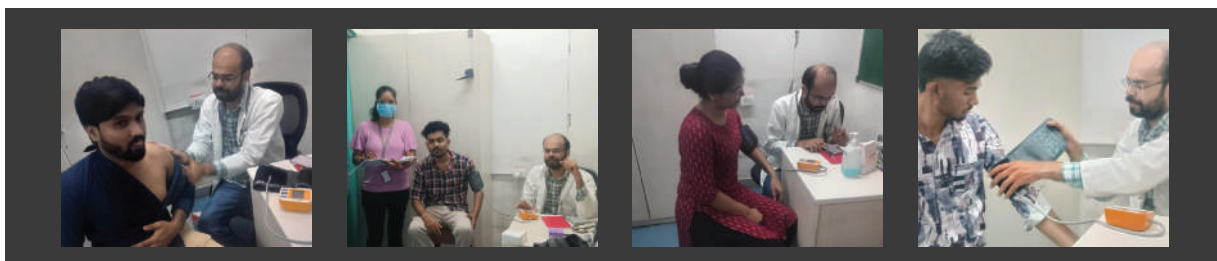
PROMOTING HEALTH. BUILDING PREPAREDNESS.

ZENZO CONDUCTS HEALTH CHECKUP CAMP FOR FLIPKART, NAGPUR & AHMEDABAD
