Growth becomes truly meaningful when it strengthens our ability to serve people better. This month reflects how disciplined execution, responsible expansion and an unwavering commitment to care can come together to create lasting impact.

Across Zenzo, we strengthened workplace medical preparedness through trained manpower and Advanced Life Support ambulance deployments. Our teams supported 22 Ahluwalia Contracts India Limited sites across five cities with 53 trained medical personnel, while ALS ambulances became operational across TATA locations at Sahibabad, Khopoli and Bhira.

At the same time, our Zenplus teams across Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Punjab continued to demonstrate preparedness and compassion on the ground - supporting critical patients, assisting emergency

deliveries and building first-responder awareness in communities.

This month also brought a proud moment as our Co-Founder and CEO, Ms. Sweta Mangal Mehta, was recognised as Healthcare Leader of the Year - National at the Financial Express Healthcare Awards 2026. ZENZO BUILDING SAFER WORKPLACES.
STRENGTHENING PREPAREDNESS.

53 RESPONDERS. 22 SITES. 5 CITIES.

When Ahluwalia Contracts India Limited set out to make site safety non-negotiable, they asked for capability on the ground. Zenzo deployed 53 trained medical personnel across 22 live locations in Delhi NCR, Noida, Jewar, Mumbai and Bangalore. Ten sites are doctor-led and staffed by AFIH-certified Factory Medical Officers, while 43 trained first aiders provide layered support at high-density locations. With an average of 2.4 responders per site, deployment is scaled to risk rather than a flat formula. Five cities are connected through one escalation matrix and one live manpower tracker, enabling same-day visibility on open positions.

ON THE FRONTLINES OF CARE

UTTAR PRADESH | ALS CREW ENSURES SAFE TRANSFER

An ALS ambulance crew responded to a critically injured patient requiring urgent medical support and transfer. The team provided continuous care and safely transported the patient for advanced treatment, demonstrating the importance of trained intervention during critical moments.



BIHAR | TIMELY SUPPORT FOR A CARDIAC PATIENT

An ambulance team in Bihar responded to a patient experiencing a cardiac emergency. Acting promptly, the crew supported the patient throughout the journey and ensured safe transfer to the appropriate healthcare facility for further care.

PUNJAB | 108 CREW ASSISTS EMERGENCY DELIVERY

A pregnant woman went into severe labour while being transported to CH Nakodar. The 108 ambulance crew responded immediately and safely assisted the delivery inside the ambulance. Both mother and newborn were then taken to hospital for further care.



PUNJAB | FIRST RESPONDER PROGRAM

A First Responder Program brought essential emergency-response knowledge to students and staff, helping participants understand how to respond during the critical golden hour. The initiative strengthens community preparedness beyond the ambulance.
